- Parenting education

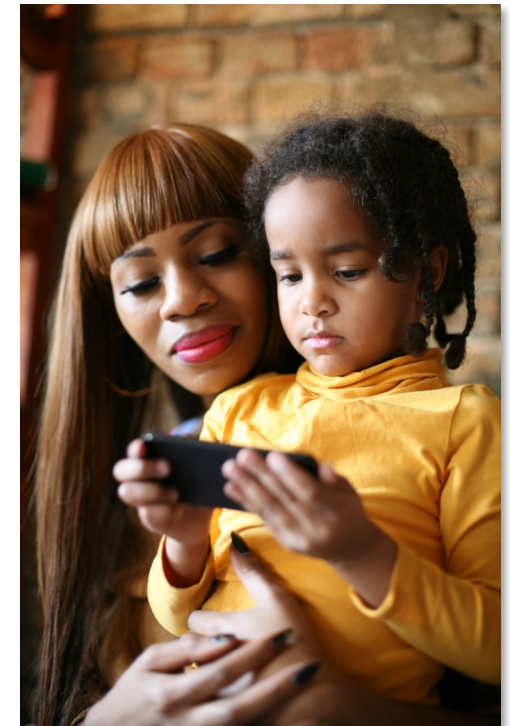
Halfway House Services

Phase II Halfway House services operate as transitional living programs providing a link between primary treatment services and a return to life in the community. Our primary goal is to provide the resident with a period of stability in an alcohol and drug-free lifestyle. This is achieved through a daily structured program that involves balanced nutrition, pleasant surroundings, and a people-oriented therapeutic environment that promotes recovery.

Temporary Assistance For Needy Families (TANF)

The Phase II/ TANF program is a long term residential treatment program designed for women who are currently pregnant or have dependent children. Women with dependent children can have up to two children reside with them during their treatment; however, it is not mandatory. We challenge ourselves to remain current with best practices in treatment services and, to this end, utilize a variety of evidenced-based treatment models ensuring that our consumers have the best opportunity for long-term success. We have worked hard to design a program that incorporates both flexibility and the structure along with stability required to achieve and maintain early recovery.
